SUNRISE AND SUNSET

Witnessing a sunset and a sunrise over Uluru and Kata Tjuta is an awe-inspiring experience and a 'must-do.' Watch the remarkable changing colours of Uluru as the sun rises or sets over the desert landscape.

Join a guided tour for an interpretive experience, venture to one of the five viewing areas inside the Park at your own pace or for a more intimate experience, climb to the top of one of the look-outs within the Resort grounds to watch the twice-daily spectacular lightshow.

The apparent colour changes of Uluru and the desert landscape result from the effects of the earth's atmosphere on the sun's incoming rays. The ash, dust particles and water vapour present in the earth's atmosphere act as a filter which can remove the bluer light from the incoming rays of the sun, allowing the redder light through at different times of day. Reflections from the rock and clouds in the sky enhance the vivid colours.
