The experience begins with a transfer from Resort hotels to a sustainability-built platform where guests can take in the stunning sunset with views out to both Uluru and Kata Tjuta with a cocktail, being before seated in the amphitheatre with a gourmet hamper celebrating native ingredients, paired perfectly with a choice of Australian wine or beer.

As darkness falls, drones, lights, traditional music, and Pitjantjatjara language will bring to life the Mala story under the desert sky.
